Jon Day is a multi-instrumentalist, educator, arranger, and composer. As an accomplished trumpet player and pianist, Jon has been a featured artist in a variety of music festivals around the globe. Jeremy Coates is one of Western Canada's busiest working bass players and has traveled throughout the United States, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand, and has performed at the Montreux jazz festival. Robin Tufts is a drummer, percussionist, and dance accompanist. Robin is very active in the Calgary jazz community, playing and recording with his own Trio, Velocity and many other groups.
