

# Oakridge Community Association (OCA): Civic Affairs Report

### **RioCan Development at Glenmore Landing**

Much continues to evolve regarding RioCan's and the City's communications and activities since our November report but unfortunately, with limited specific details. The initial 'Land Use Amendment' - LOC2023-0130 for RioCan's proposed redevelopment at Glenmore Landing has been revised for lower towers but with the same number of units/residents. Additionally, an original 'Public Notice' about the sale of Parkland adjacent to Glenmore Landing was subsequently revised with comments required by November 20 with a Council meeting planned for early January 2024. Late submissions on the sale of Parkland may be accepted at realestateinquiries@calgary.ca. There are different views on the facts so if you are interested, be sure to research both sides.

Much to our frustration, we have been unsuccessful in obtaining preliminary details on the traffic analysis, now over six months old. Oakridge and other community residents will remember the delays at 90 Ave and 14 St, during the BRT construction, so this will be important, especially with more residents at the proposed Jewish Centre expansion, the new Co-op development, the Taza developments, densification within District 32 communities, and more traffic using 90 Avenue from the ring road. We continue to request the 'Traffic Impact Analysis' (TIA) report as this should detail the anticipated additional congestion during construction and subsequently during ongoing occupation. Most recently (November 9), we have been advised by RioCan that the TIA will be available from the City once approved. We need some time to evaluate this report to determine the assumptions used by RioCan's consultants and the ongoing finalization required by the City.

# Southland Crossing – Co-op Development and Construction Plans

Construction of the new food store has commenced with a planned opening for early 2025. Once the new food store is open, Co-op will demolish the current food store, and begin the final phase of the project which includes residential development slated to be complete for 2026.

### **Oakridge Area Upgrade Projects**

We continue to support various projects including road calming measures at pedestrian crossings, such as Palliser Dr, 29 St and Oakwood Dr, as well as Southland Drive and Oakmoor Way where posted speeds are 60 km/hr. Please use the City of Calgary's link at https://www.calgary.ca/311.html to document any road safety or infrastructure issues. Recently, some benches were donated by a local resident and placed in several locations. Unfortunately, the City has identified several issues with these benches, including the fact that no service requests were made via 3-1-1, so the OCA Board has been approached regarding options, and these will be discussed by the OCA Board.

### District 32+

Generally, we will discuss issues common to our neighbouring communities and community associations. Canyon Meadows has now joined our activities, hence our expanded name District 32+. Common topics range from the RioCan expansion at Glenmore Landing, road safety, and development permits to future LAP issues.
