

Warm Up this Fall with Delicious Pumpkin Soup!



As the leaves start to fall and the weather begins to cool, there's nothing quite like a warm bowl of soup to comfort and nourish you. This pumpkin soup recipe is the perfect way to enjoy the flavours of fall while staying cozy and satisfied.

Made with roasted pumpkin, aromatic spices, and a savory broth, this soup is easy to make and is bursting with flavour. Whether you're looking for a hearty lunch or a comforting dinner, this recipe is sure to please.

Grab your apron and let's get cooking!

Ingredients:

- 1 medium-sized pumpkin
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 4 cups chicken or vegetable broth
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Optional toppings: croutons, sour cream, chopped parsley

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 375°F. Cut the pumpkin in half and remove the seeds and pulp.
- 2. Brush the pumpkin halves with olive oil and place them cut side down on a baking sheet. Roast for 45 minutes or until the flesh is tender.
- 3. Remove the pumpkin from the oven and let it cool. Scoop out the flesh and set it aside.
- 4. In a large pot, sauté the onion and garlic in olive oil until they are soft and golden.
- 5. Add the roasted pumpkin flesh, chicken or vegetable broth, cinnamon, nutmeg, ginger, salt, and pepper to the pot. Bring to a boil.
- 6. Reduce the heat and let the soup simmer for 20 to 25 minutes.
- 7. Use an immersion blender or transfer the soup to a blender and blend until smooth.
- 8. Serve hot with your desired toppings.

On Demand Transit Service Update


After a successful pilot of on demand transit service in Springbank Hill communities, ridership has increased to a level supporting fixed-route service.

On September 4, 2023, on demand service in Aspen Woods, Christie Park, Strathcona Park, Signal Hill, Springbank Hill, and Discovery Ridge was replaced with fixed-route service, and you'll no longer be able to book on demand trips to or from these communities. On demand will continue to provide a service in Carrington and Livingston.

The New Routes Serving Springbank Hill Are:

- Route 51 West Springs/Discovery Ridge (replacing current route 453 - West Springs)
- Route 94 Strathcona/Signal Hill
- Route 164 Aspen Summit/Richmond Terminal
- Existing Routes 93 Coach Hill/Westbrook Station, 98 - Cougar Ridge, 111 - Old Banff Coach Road, and 156 - Aspen Woods will remain unchanged.



Calgary Home to Western Canada's First-Of-Its-Kind Outdoor Urban Bouldering Park



A new, unique, and free-to-use climbing boulder feature is opening at Millennium Park. Working with Montreal-based climbing wall manufacturer OnSite, these climbing boulders consist of three natural rocks ranging in height from 3.6m to 4.25m and weighing between 11 to 27 metric tonnes. The boulders were installed earlier this summer and are now open for public use.

The boulders will offer routes for all skill levels as they have up to 60 established problems or climbing routes that were set by a team of talented Canadian climbers, including Sonnie Trotter who is widely regarded as one of Canada's top rock climbers, and Calgary-based Josh Muller, who has been climbing at the sport's top level for decades. Both climbers own climbing gyms and have extensive route-setting experience indoors and outdoors.

Climbers will have to bring their own crash pads, helmet, and climbing shoes. For everyone's safety and enjoyment, we ask the public to read the permanent safety advisories before using the bouldering area. These instructions are available on the webpage and installed at the bouldering site

In addition to these new boulders, Millennium Park is home to North America's largest skatepark, has basketball and beach volleyball courts, a stage and amphitheater for events, and more. For more information about this park, visit Calgary.ca/MillenniumPark.
