

The WSCR Community Garden beds are open and available to rent on our website at https://wscr.ca/whats-happening.

Community gardening is a great way to help get you moving, and the WSCR community garden offers a relaxing place where you can meet your neighbours. In addition, community gardening is a great way to help reduce your grocery bill. With the rising cost of food, paying less to eat is something we can all benefit from.

Smoked Salmon and Cucumber Bites



Are you searching for an appetizer to serve at your upcoming get-together? Why not give Smoked Salmon and Cucumber Bites a shot! These elegant and tasty bites are ideal for any springtime event, whether it's a laid-back brunch or an Easter dinner!

Ingredients:

- Smoked salmon slices
- Cucumber
- Cream cheese
- Dill (optional)
- · Lemon juice (optional)
- Black pepper

Instructions:

- 1. Thinly slice the cucumber into rounds.
- Spread a layer of cream cheese on each cucumber slice.
- 3. Top the cream cheese with a piece of smoked salmon.
- 4. Garnish with a sprig of dill and a squeeze of lemon juice.
- 5. Season with black pepper to taste.
- 6. Arrange the bites on a platter and serve chilled.

Short-Term Rental Business Licence Changes in Effect



Changes making short-term rental practices in Calgary safer are now in effect. As of January 1, 2024, Council's approved amendments to the Business Licence Bylaw governing short-term rental business licences are aimed at bolstering accountability, ensuring safety and fostering a positive community impact. These revisions represent a step forward in the City's commitment to responsible short-term rental practices. These changes, approved by Council last June, are applicable to both new applicants and renewing hosts and operators.

All current and prospective short-term rental hosts are required to have a business licence to provide temporary accommodation for compensation.

Key changes to the business licence application include:

- Proof of the property owner's consent, and if located in a condo, proof of the condominium board's consent, for the short-term rental to be offered to guests for compensation.
- A fire safety plan, which includes the floor plan required to be posted inside the short-term rental.
- A fire inspection to ensure safety standards are met and to validate the allowable number of guests.
- Proof of liability insurance coverage for the short-term rental.
- A review of the property for prior concerns.

Calgary Animal Services - Pet Licensing



Calgary Animal Services emphasizes the importance of licensing your pets. Licensing your pet is not only a legal requirement but also a crucial step in ensuring their quick and safe return if they happen to get lost. The cost for licensing a cat is \$21 per year and for a dog it is \$44 per year.

Licensing your pet ensures your participation in the City's First Ride Home program. If your pet becomes lost, rather than incurring fees for both pet retrieval and lacking a license, your animal will be safely returned to you without any additional cost. Peace officers will personally attempt to deliver your pet to your home using the information linked to their license. This eliminates the need for your pet to be brought to the Animal Services Centre, reducing the stress for both you and your pet, and the potential for added fees after the first day at the shelter.



2024 Property Assessment

The 2024 property assessment values are based on a July 1, 2023, market valuation date and the property's physical condition on December 31, 2023. The total value of the 2024 Assessment Roll is \$387 billion, an increase of \$35 billion from last year. Overall, the typical residential property market value change is a ten per cent increase over the previous year, while the typical non-residential market value change is three per cent. The 2024 median single residential assessment is \$610,000, compared to \$555,000 in 2023. The 2024 median residential condominium assessment is \$295,000 compared to \$255,000 in 2023.

When property assessments arrive, most residents will notice that their property's value has increased from last year due to vigorous sales and market demand. Calgary's housing market remains strong with robust sales indicating continued strength and real estate market confidence throughout the city.


