



WSCR Community Garden Has Beds Available to Rent

Gardeners are itching for the first days of warm weather so we can start planting our favourite vegetables, fruits, and herbs. Planting will tentatively begin on May 15.

Have you always thought about renting a garden bed, but thought about it too late in the season? Not this year! The WSCR Community Garden still has beds available.

Did you know that peas, spinach, onions, and carrots can be seeded outdoors in our community garden once the soil is workable. That's because the soil in our raised beds warms up faster in spring and it also stays warmer longer in the fall. As a result, our gardeners can extend their growing season a few weeks and that allows them to reap larger harvests. Some vegetables can even be sown multiple times during the growing season!

Another great thing about community gardening is that it helps reduce your grocery bill. With the rising cost of food, paying less to eat is something we can all benefit from. Gardening also helps get you moving, and the WSCR community garden offers a relaxing place where you can meet some of your neighbours.

Benefit of joining the WSCR Community Gardens:

- Welcome beginner and expert gardeners.
- Help build a sense of community.

Bed rentals cost \$50 for the season, and the fee includes access to water onsite plus use of the tools in our fully stocked sheds. Current gardeners get first access during the annual renewal period, and individuals can rent up to two beds. At the time of writing, we have beds available, but they get rented quickly as the weather warms up. So don't delay - sign up for your bed today!

Helping Calgarians Navigate Construction Season

With construction season kicking off in Calgary, The City is working to help you get around, whether you walk, wheel, take transit, or drive.

Throughout construction season and year-round, The City's Mobility Operations Centre (MOC) actively monitors and responds to real-time traffic conditions, including impacts of construction and things like weather, incidents, and other unplanned events. They use advanced technologies like dynamic road signs, traffic cameras, traffic signal timing, and lane reversals to alleviate congestion and keep traffic flowing smoothly.

Know your options and plan ahead. Visit Calgary.ca/ trafficinfo for current and planned closures, traffic volumes, and real-time traffic cameras.

- Follow @yyctransport on X for current road conditions, traffic incidents, and planned closures and detours.
- Tune in to The City's traffic advisory radio station at 107.9 or the radio traffic report of your choice.
- Use your favourite trip-planning tools like Waze or Google Maps. The City shares information to help keep them up to date.

Repairing Potholes this Spring



Repairing potholes is an important part of the City of Calgary's road maintenance. Permanent repairs can only be made during the spring/summer months when warmer weather and dry pavement allows the asphalt to set properly.

Pothole repairs are completed by operational crews and identified in 3-1-1 citizen reports and through routine inspections. Inspections are completed and repairs are prioritized using a five-point scale based on pothole severity, safety impacts and location.

If you notice a pothole, check their online pothole map to see if it already has a repair request, and if not, report it at calgary.ca/potholes or call 3-1-1.

Why a Rain Barrel?

Water Conservation. Rain barrels help conserve water by capturing rainwater that would otherwise be lost to runoff. By using collected rainwater to water your yard or garden, you're doing your part to help use water wisely, which is especially crucial when we're experiencing drought conditions. Your plants will also appreciate the soft, warm water.
