





- Store your carts inside a garage or other secure enclosure.



# Free Yard Waste Drop-Off at City Eco Centres



#### April 11 to June 1

This is useful for residential households when:

- You have too much yard waste for your green cart
- Your yard waste is too large or oversized for your green cart

#### **Eco Centre Requirements**

Loads should only have leaves, branches, plants, and grass clippings. Shake the soil off plants and roots.

We do not accept sod or food scraps. Put these items in your green cart. If you bring sod, you will be charged the basic sanitary rate.

Commercial customers with yard waste will be subject to regular landfill fees. Commercial loads are also not accepted at Shepard.

For faster service, we suggest visiting the Eco Centre on a weekday or before 9:00 am on Saturdays when wait times are shorter.





#### **Good Food Box**

The Good Food Box Program is a program under the Community Kitchen Program of Calgary whereby anyone can purchase boxes of fresh fruits and vegetables at an affordable price.

Each Good Food Box contains a combination of fruits and vegetables. The content varies monthly, due to seasonal availability.

#### **Pricing and Sizes**

Small: \$30 for 15 to 20lbs
Medium: \$35 for 25 to 30lbs
Large: \$40 for 35 to 40lbs

\*Please note weights are approximate.

Orders are placed monthly through the Woodcreek Community Association office and can be made in person, over the phone, or online. Payment is due at the time of ordering and no refunds can be issued. If you would like to donate a Good Food Box to our community pantry, please select 'donate a box' when ordering.

#### **Tree Canopy**


The Woodcreek Community Association is working with the City of Calgary to improve our community by increasing the tree canopy. We will look at trees on medians and boulevards, the need for pruning newly planted trees, identify where trees are missing after having died, lost by accidents, broken by storms, or whatever other fate led to their demise. We are also looking at the planting of trees in our sports fields to provide shade and picnic areas. The Poplar trees along many of our streets provide the best forest canopy in our community and many are reaching their end of life, so we will need to carefully consider how we manage their replacement. There are other community beautification initiatives we can research to make Woodbine and Woodlands better.

The list is more than one person can manage. The City of Calgary has implemented a Tree Ambassador Program to help provide input for improving the urban forest canopy in our community. The Tree Ambassador acts as a liaison between our community and the City of Calgary.


